

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

1. In the following Definitions of Classes First Prize wins in Limited Show Obedience Classes and Open Shows confined to one breed do not count for entry in Open and Championship Show Obedience Classes but do count for eligibility at Limited Obedience Shows or Open Shows confined to one breed.

2. A dog must be entered in the lowest scheduled class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another class if desired plus one additional class at the societies' discretion. A dog may only be entered in two classes at this show unless competing in the special KCGCDS pre-beginners class or the ABC class when they may be entered in a maximum of two other classes for which they are eligible.

To enter KCGCDS Spec Pre-Beginner Stake the dog and handler must be eligible to enter Pre-Beginners and the dog must have gained its GCDS Bronze Award prior to the closing date for entries.

PRE-BEGINNERS to compete in Pre-Beginners a handler and dog must not have won a FIRST PRIZE in either Pre-Beginners or Beginners nor gained a third place or above in any other obedience class. (Introductory Class excepted).

BEGINNERS To compete in Beginners a handler or dog must not have won a total of two or more FIRST PRIZE in Beginners Class, or one FIRST PRIZE in any other Obedience Class, (Introductory Class or Pre-Beginners excepted).

NOVICE for dogs which have not won two FIRST PRIZES in Obedience Classes. (Introductory Class, Pre-Beginners and Beginners excepted).

CLASS A For dogs which have not won three FIRST PRIZES in Class A, B and Open Class C in total.

CLASS B For dogs which have not won three FIRST PRIZES in Class B and Open Class C in total.

OPEN CLASS C At Open Shows, and in the Open C Classes held at Championship Shows, open to all dogs.

Special ABC Class (Anything but a Collie) Open to all dogs other than a Collie, WSD or Collie X Pre-Beg to C

Directions to the Venue

From the South: Leave Aberdeen on the A90, heading North following the directions signs for Fraserburgh.

Leaving the A90 at the Toll of Birness joining the A952, still following signs for Fraserburgh.

In Mintlaw Village, at the first roundabout take the first exit onto Station Road, following the signs for Aden Park which is on the left after Mintlaw Academy.

Some Sat-Navs may try to take you in the back gate of the park – ensure you carry on into Mintlaw to the roundabout as above.

From the North : (Banff/Moray) On entering Mintlaw, Aden Park is the first junction on the right.

(Fraserburgh) on entering Mintlaw at the roundabout take the third exit onto Station Road, follow the signs for Aden Park.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are to be read in conjunction with the Kennel Club Obedience Show Regulations G under which this show is licensed. It is the responsibility of everyone entering this show to make themselves familiar with the Kennel Club G Regulations, available from the Kennel Club.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Only dogs of six calendar months of age and over are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed obedience shows.
4. A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes
5. Organisers of Open Obedience Shows may set a capping level on the entries to be accepted in any standard or special class and may decline entries received after the capping level has been reached. no capping limit is set at this show.
6. Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their full details recorded on the entry form.
7. Internet entries are not available for this show.
8. Running orders will only be published on Obedience UK UNLESS clearly stated on your entry form you wish this information by email or post.
9. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
10. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped, addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date. The refund will be paid within 3 months of the show date.
11. In classes without a full running order dogs will be received until one hour after the commencement of judging (ie **11 am**) after which no dogs may be received except under unforeseen and exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
12. Timed stays will take place and will take priority over other tests; the times will be published at the Show and in the catalogue.
- 13 For the duration of the show all dogs, including those in the exercise area, must be on a lead except when competing or practising prior to competition.
14. The mating of bitches within the precinct of the competition is forbidden.
15. Animals allowed in Event: No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times

16. Following a discussion between the Chief Steward and the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon a dog shall be prevented from competing and or removed from the show if it is: a) a bitch which is in season b) suffering from any infectious or prevented from competing and/or removed from the Show if it is; a) a bitch in season b) suffering from any infectious or contagious disease c) interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent d) of such temperament or is so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal e) likely to cause suffering to the dog is it continues competing
The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the show incident book and submitted to the Kennel Club..
17. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
18. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
19. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
20. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
21. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
22. No prize money is on offer at this show
- 23 DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS: Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

24. Welfare of Dogs: A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

25. Food and or toys will not be carried or given to a dog under test except in the introductory class where silent toy and food not distract other dogs when rewarding their dogs with food, toys or play. (REFER TO OBEDIENCE CODE OF CONDUCT.)
